## MODIFIED RULES - FOR HUME LEAGUE UNDER. 14's COMPETITION

Following a meeting at Lockhart (15/03/99) of Junior Officials and decisions made at a Directors Meeting of the League at Walla (24/03/99) the following modified rules are compulsory for all U.14's games (including finals).

Clubs are to make Club Umpires/Coaches/Players/Parents/Officials etc fully aware of these modified rules.

- 1. Players are limited to one (1) bounce or touching of the ball on the ground before disposing of the ball the ball must be kicked or hand balled to a team mate before the afore said player can regain possession and continue play.
- 2. A mark is any "catch" of the ball from the foot of another player regardless of the distance the ball has travelled.
- Out of Bounds:
  - if kicked out the ball is to be brought back into play by a player of the opposing team.
  - if forced out off hands the Umpire is to throw the ball up with players of similar size contesting the "ruck".
- 4. Umpires to use a five (5) minute "sin bin" for illegal/unruly/undisciplined play two such "sin bins" result in the player being sent off for the remainder of the game.

  (NOTE: If the Umpire/s are of the opinion that a players actions warrant further penalty they are to use the Report Book and place the matter in the hands of the League).
- 5. Only official runners/trainers are permitted on the ground during actual play coaches are not permitted on the ground during play. (In the case of "serious" injury common sense would prevail.)
- 6. A size 4 "all weather" ball must be used in all games.
- 7. Whilst kicking off the ground is not a penalty it is to be discouraged and umpires urged to encourage players to attempt to take possession of the ball.
- 8. A 15m penalty is to be used in place of the normal 50m penalty.
- 9. The "SPIRIT" of the game of Australian Football is at all times paramount and all concerned umpires/coaches/players/parents/officials etc are urged to keep in mind the aim of the League is to "provide a game of football for our kids to enjoy."
